



Clubhouse Dress Code

At Milnerton we intend not to be too formal in and around the clubhouse. There are However certain minimum standards expected from visitors, members & guests in terms of dress code in the Clubhouse. The club will uphold a standard of “smart casual” dress at all times.

The following guidelines are set to assist members, guests & management of the club to achieve this goal.

ACCEPTABLE DRESS

- Shirts with collar, sleeves & golf shirts.
- Tailored trousers & tailored shorts (Bermudas).
- Smart unfaded denims/jeans.
- Mock necked (tiger) shirts.
- Smart casual type footwear - docksiders, smart sandals (leather type).
- soft spikes golf shoes.
- Ladies may wear accepted golf shirts / blouses/ polo necks.
- Ladies may wear tailored skirts / dresses / slacks /shorts.

NOT PERMITTED

- Beach sandals or ‘flip flops’ or gym / pool sandals.
- Beach wear / jogging gear / gym gear / cycling gear.
- Golfing headgear in the clubhouse lounge / bar / halfway.
- Sleeveless shirts / vests (men)
- Sloganed t/shirts.
- Drawstring shorts or trousers.
- Torn or faded jeans.
- Sloppy untidy dress code.

Staff members have been given strict instructions to address all breaches of dress code & request patrons to rectify/correct immediately. Clubhouse staff will not enter into discussions with any clubhouse ‘users’ in this regard. Failure to comply may result in patrons being asked to vacate the premises.

We trust that you respect the rules and wishes of Milnerton Golf Club & their desire to maintain a minimum set of standards & codes at the club
